Ms. Clipper, who provides contract management and oversight for mental health programs totaling more than \$8 million and provides intensive program oversight for 19 adult mobile crisis teams, shows great dedication and compassion to individuals in recovery.

Clinical services and medication support are vital aspects of the recovery process, and Federation began partnering with Community Care Rx, a long-term care pharmacy providing services throughout the New York metropolitan area, two years ago. Dr. Maksoud, who founded Community Care Rx in 2010, and his team have provided Federation with the support and collaboration needed to allow for a seamless and successful transition. Dr. Maksoud supports

Federation's clients and programs by ensuring timely and accurate delivery of essential medications and services.

Federation also thanked its clients, its staff and its supporters for their extraordinary collaboration throughout the pandemic.
